ABOUT THIS CURRICULUM

Welcome. This workbook was created with the simple belief that students learn best when enjoyment and meaning come together. Over the years we have seen the power of **learning through song** and growing from a foundation of faith.

This curriculum is designed for children **ages 7 to 10**. Younger learners may need more hands-on help. Older students can usually complete the activities independently with minimal support. **This volume contains 8 units**. We recommend completing one unit per week.

Why We Use Music, Reading, and Writing Together

This program blends three powerful learning tools. **Music** helps children absorb rhythm, pronunciation, and expression through both speaking and singing. **Reading** the lyrics trains the eye and the ear to work together, helping students notice patterns and retain meaning. **Writing** the activities gives children a chance to slow down, think, and practice what they have learned with their own hands.

On the right side of this page, you will find a simple guide explaining how to use these audio resources. The vocabulary reading is an additional track that works especially well just before completing the worksheets, reinforcing pronunciation before written practice.

Appendix

The appendix at the back includes the song lyrics, a small-words cheat sheet, and the answer key. These resources can be useful throughout the lessons. It is helpful to laminate these pages so they last longer and can be reused each week.

SUGGESTED RHYTHMS



Step 1: Reading Lyrics

The lyrics may feel long or unfamiliar at first, and that is completely normal. With repetition and gentle practice each week, your child will grow more comfortable and confident. What feels new in the beginning will soon feel natural and enjoyable.

Weeks 1 to 2

- You read each line aloud (or play the audio)
- The student repeats, line by line.

Weeks 5 to 6

- The student reads the lyrics with you or with audio
- Students try to translate after each line read.

Weeks 3 to 4

- You read each line aloud (or play the audio)
- The teacher helps as needed.

Weeks 7-8

- The student reads all the lyrics out loud two lines at a time and translates as they go



Step 2: Singing and Music

Singing is added gradually to ensure students build confidence without feeling overwhelmed.

- In **week 1**, children simply listen to the song to get used to the rhythm.
- In **weeks 2 and 3**, they listen while following with the lyrics.
- In **week 4** and continuing to **week 8**, they begin trying to sing along.

Step 3: Worksheets and Writing Practice



Each unit includes four worksheet pages that help children practice vocabulary, grammar, and reading skills.

When you see a box with a light bulb, those words are only there to help complete the exercise. They are not part of the main vocabulary and do not need to be memorized. Each unit focuses on the same 4 to 5 core words introduced at the beginning.



When you see a **flag icon**, it marks a short teaching note. It is helpful to read this part aloud to younger students before starting the exercises. All activities in the unit are designed to reinforce the same core vocabulary in different ways, building confidence through repetition.

Object Pronoun Order

In English we say: He brings me. But in French it flips and sounds like: He me brings. Silly right? Another example is "He loves you" in French sounds like "He you loves. The little words like me, you, him, her always go before the verb in French. Here are the main ones (you do not need to remember them yet):

me → me (pronounced "muh")
te → you (singular)

lui → him/her (pronounced "lwee")
nous → us (pronounced "noo")

vous → you (polite or many people)
leur → them

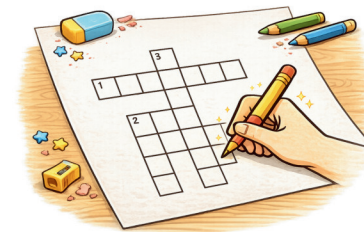
